What is a suspended coffee?

A 'suspended coffee' is a pre-paid coffee (or other beverage or food) that your customers purchase at your café to be given to someone else. Service of the coffee is suspended until it is claimed by someone who needs it for whatever reason.

How do I track the program in my café?

There are many ways to track the program, and you can choose what best fits your needs. Many of our cafés use chalkboards to note suspended items. Others use tokens, empty cups stacked by the register, or even something as simple as a piece of paper or post-it notes. If you need help deciding, we're happy to assist. We also have a Facebook group specifically for our supporting cafés where you can ask questions and share ideas.

Who is eligible?

It is important to remember that we never judge a book by its cover. Regardless of a person's appearance, if they ask for a suspended item, there is some sort of need, and they won't be turned down. When we say 'in need' it doesn't just mean someone who appears homeless or 'looks' like they are in need. It may be a single mother of 4 who cannot afford coffee in this month's grocery shopping; a well-groomed man in a business suit may be in his 16th week of job hunting; or it may be a student struggling with his exams. We don't know their situation, so we never pre-judge. No resumé needed.
